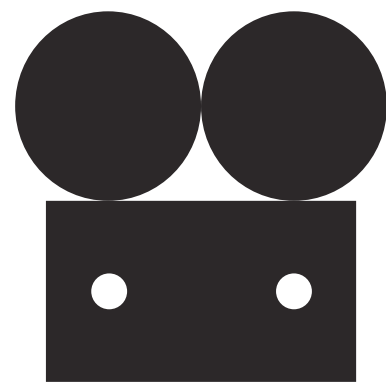


Luce and the Rock

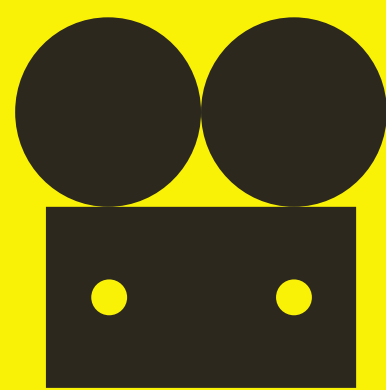
Mironins

Countless pranks (be warned: the pet is completely disinterested in cleanliness and good taste), laughter, suspense and a distinct nutritional message join forces in an delightful stop motion animated film, which opened this year's GenerationKplus of the Berlin Film Festival.



The Path

Tobias Wiemann, 99', Germany, 2022, in German/Spanish with Greek and English subtitles

The Path tells the story of an adventurous escape across the Pyrenees and of an unexpected friendship between two children who, at first glance, could hardly be more different. 1940: Rolf (12) has fled Berlin with his father Ludwig to escape the Nazis. All he was able to take with him from Germany was his lively terrier Adi and a signed book by Erich Kästner. Now father and son are stranded in the south of France. Their destination is New York, where Rolf's mother has been waiting for them for far too long. The only way to freedom is via a steep path in the Pyrenees. At the border to Spain they meet their "smuggler": Nuria, a shepherd girl, hardly older than Rolf. But when Rolf's father is arrested on the path, Rolf and Nuria are on their own. For the city boy Rolf and the country girl Nuria, a dangerous journey into the unknown begins, once across the Pyrenees to Foix. A journey on which they will learn both from each other and to trust each other. In the end, the two become friends for life.



Captain Nova

In 2050, Earth has become a dry and desolate place. Fighter pilot Nova is forced to travel back in time to prevent a devastating environmental disaster. When, however, an unforeseen side-effect of time travel makes Nova young again, she crash-lands into 2025 as a twelve-year old. Nobody seems to take her and her mission seriously, except for Nas - a teen who tries to keep this mysterious girl and her little flying robot ADD out of the hands of the secret service. Will Nova and Nas succeed in saving the future world



How I Learned To Fly

Radivoje Andrić, 85', Serbia/Croatia/Bulgaria/Slovakia, 2022, in Serbian/Croatian with Greek and English subtitles

Adventurous and funny Sofija (12) is forced to spend her vacation with her overbearing grandmother Maria (67), on an island in Croatia. It's not the ideal summer experience she had hoped for, but with the help of her warmhearted old aunt Luce (65) and her charming cousin, Sofija overcomes her initial boredom. She makes new friends and together they explore everything the summer on the island has to offer: sparkling sun, fun in the water, lots of ice cream and her first kiss. But her carefree time comes to an abrupt end, when beloved Luce has to be taken to hospital, leaving Sofija with a part of her family she didn't even know existed. Nevertheless, in the wake of tragedy, the family finally overcomes old traumas and when Sofija returns home, she realizes that revealing painful secrets is challenging but very liberating.

An entertaining family film that takes you on a charming, yet emotional summer adventure by the sea.



A Butterfly's Heart

Inesa Kurklietyte, 105', Lithuania, 2021, in Lithuanian with Greek and English subtitles

Juozapas has a big secret. His heart is protected by a glass dome and thick armour. Wanting to protect him from the sharpness of human relationships, his parents avoid making him interact with other children. He spends his days in an old deserted manor where he raises insects. His time in solitude is disrupted when a similarly aged girl, Rugilė, moves in town. Through their growing friendship, Juozapas will muster the courage to overcome his fears and to confront daily hardship with open arms. This multi-awarded Lithuanian film comments on the themes of bullying and the therapeutic effects of true friendship in a creative and original manner.



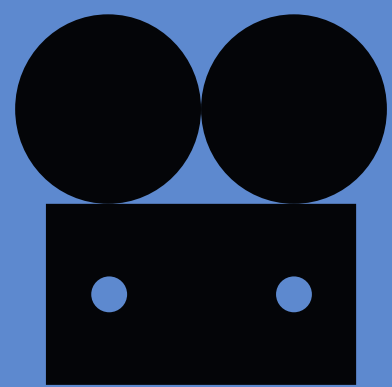
Far.Go.Bots

Aggelos Tsaousis, 115', Greece, 2022, in Greek with English subtitles

Within Roma communities, it is common for children to drop out of school at the age of 13 to get married. But this is not the case for the children of the first Roma Robotics team of the "Lighthouse of the World", who managed to travel to St. Louis (USA) to participate at the First Lego League (World Robotics Championship), finish school and change their lives forever. The "Lighthouse of the World" is a protection center for Roma minors founded in 2004 by Father Athinagoras in Dendropotamos, Thessaloniki. Dendropotamos is a poor and degraded area, a so-called ghetto, and its schools report high rates of dropouts. Father Athinagoras managed, with perseverance and determination, to bring the children of the community closer to education. When robotics class was introduced at the center, the children learned to collaborate, communicate, play and dream of a world beyond Dendropotamos. The film follows the children for 7 years, from 2014 to 2021, recording their life trajectories along with their participation in the robotics workshop. We watch them transform from shy children into charismatic young people, who with optimism and hard work break down stereotypes and contribute to their community.

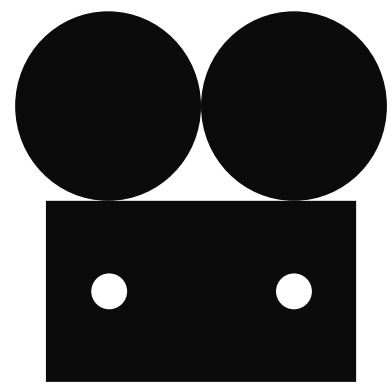

Christine Doyon, 17', Canada, 2021, in French with Greek and English subtitles

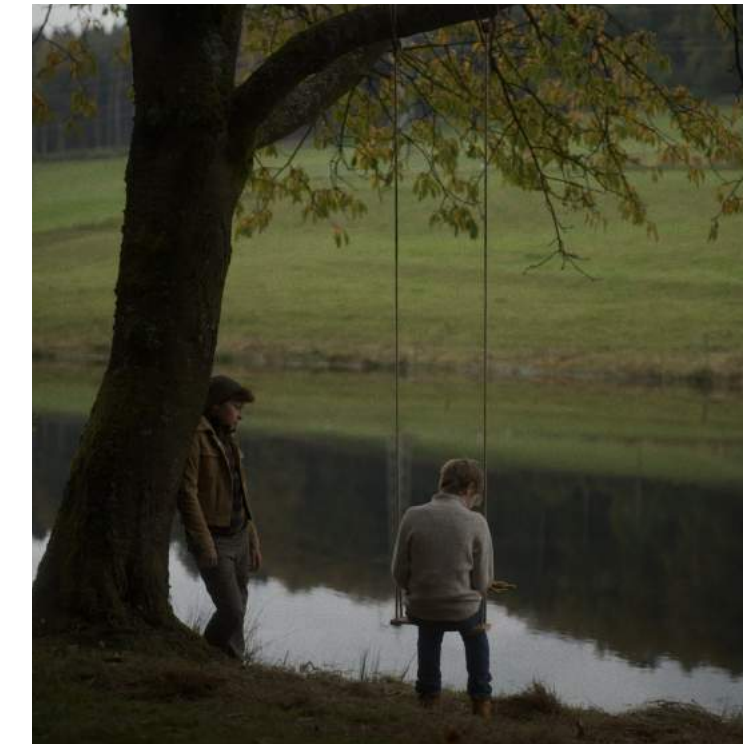

First up: cut off her long hair. Second: don't read any more books. Third: never take care of something that's alive. And fourth: become a stand-up comedian to make her papa laugh again. On her way, Sasha can count on the support from friends and family, even if they can't always follow her moves, like when she tells one of her bad jokes. The difficult subject of loss is treated with tenderness, patience and humour. Laughter and tears alternate masterfully in this award-winning, bittersweet film about the search for identity and the journey through the tunnel of grief to the light of reconciliation with it.

Her teammates despise her and she has to prepare for the championships just as the Euromaidan popular revolution breaks out in Kiev involving everyone she cares about. A gripping, human story about the conflict between personal ambition and duty towards the homeland, set against the backdrop of the historic events in Ukraine in 2013 but reasserting its relevance and symbolism today, starring the real-life athlete Anastasia Boudiaskina, whose face reflects not only the anguish of a girl who just wants to belong somewhere, but also the entire anguish of a people.

The juries are hosted each year by the European Children's Film Association member festivals, which add their respective winners to a pan-European shortlist of nominees competing for the grand prize in their category. The winners are announced each year during the Berlin Film Festival.

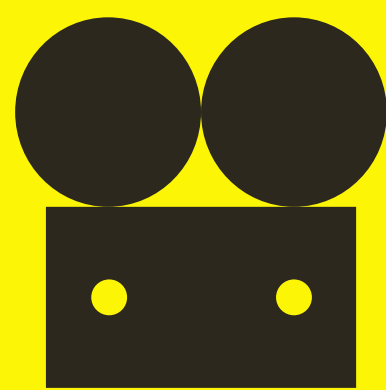
Markéta Pášmová

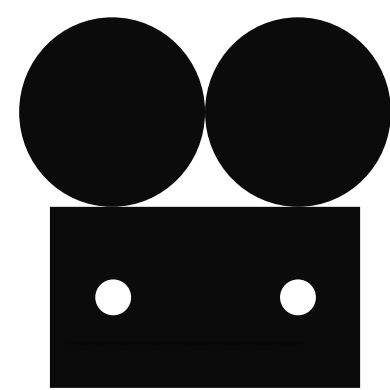


Catarina Ramalho

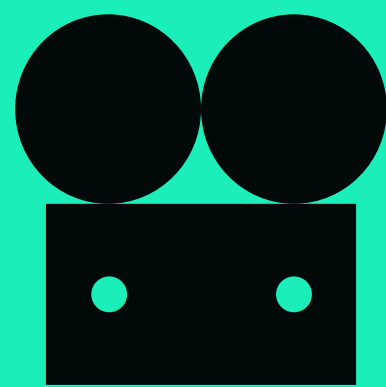

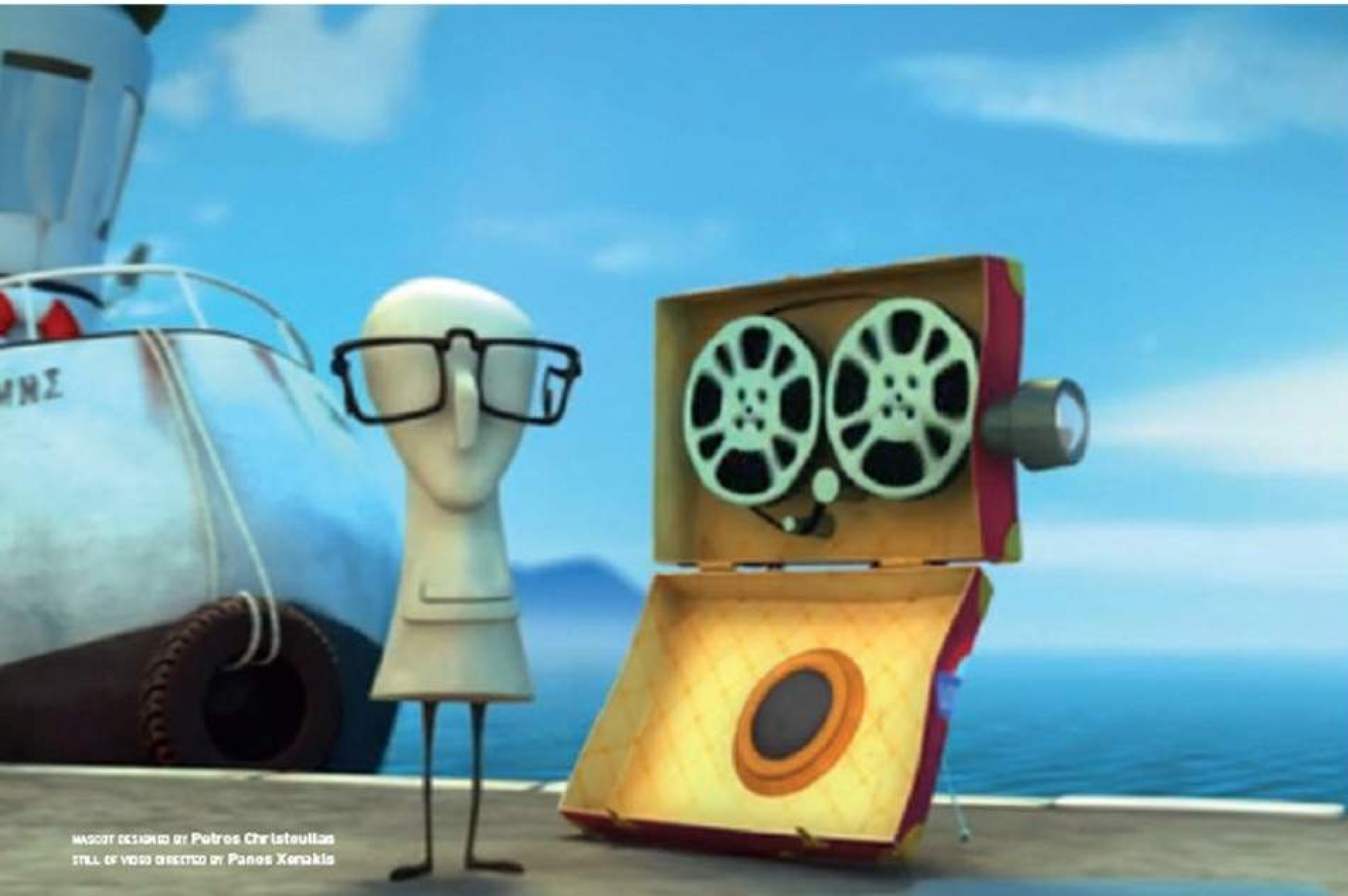

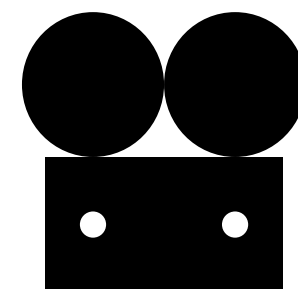
